**Meeting called to order* by Chair, Tunde Zsido at 5:43 pm

*Minutes from the January meeting were approved.

New Business

*Spring Show: Tunde thanked Danny and Max for serving as Chair and Assistant Chair for the show.

Report from Danny: Show is on! Danny thanked us all for our help and especially for the help we *will* be doing. We want to have fun AND we want to turn a profit. Danny sent out copy of the form to use to sell program adds. Be sure to tell potential advertisers that this is a **KEEPSAKE** add. These programs stay around for a very long time. Selling of these adds is not a requirement. But, if every member would sell one add, we would make \$1800 profit.

Dianna has volunteered to be the chair of the Creative committee. Sherri has volunteered to be the chair of the Support committee. Chairs are going to try and match members to their perceived strengths and experience and then ask members to do specific tasks. April 13 pictures will be taken. April 24 is the school outreach performance. There are currently 260 students committed to attending. The goal is to have all choreography and costumes finished by April 20th. There will be practices during the week of the show. Becca added to the parents of the soloist, the sooner you come to us with your music choice, the better, so they can get the skating order done.

*Spice on Ice: Tunde attended EIC roundtable meeting. EIC asks that each user group have members purchase a table and donate an auction item. Betz has agreed to donate Jazz tickets and Tunde will talk to Linda about getting a restaurant donation in SLC to go along with it. Spice on Ice is March 28th. There are three levels of tables available to purchase and \$50 seats. Auction items must be declared by March 16th. The item should be something unique, not something that you could just go out and buy. Tunde wants to remind us all we can exist without a club but we cannot exist without a rink.

*Nomination Committee: Tracy volunteered to chair the committee. Betz agreed to serve on the committee.

*RAPZ tax: Danny spoke with Linda; Linda is looking at putting in a dollar amount that would be enough to cover some clinics and help cover operational costs for the rink during the summer. Linda understands the criteria and will be submitting the application by the deadline.

Chris Ball originally set up the website. Betz will put Sherry in touch with Chris. Kim also said she would be able to create a new web page. Those mentioned above will continue to work on this.
